Have you taken care of your assessment yet?

TRASH ROOM - Each trash room has two (2) large recycle bins. As you face the bins, the one on the left is for newspapers and thin boxes (ex: flattened cereal boxes). The recycle bin on the right is for **CLEAN** plastic, glass and metal can containers only. **There is also a small metal can for used batteries.** If bins are not in the Trash Room, you **MUST** take your trash back to your unit, do not leave anything on the floor. This will help prevent insects and make it easier for the pest control person to spray. **Any garbage that goes down the chute, including cleaned styrofoam food containers, must be put in plastic bags (13 gallon) and securely tied, anything larger is to be placed in a bag and put in the outside dumpsters.** All cardboard is to be cut up (there is a box cutter on the wall in the Compactor Room) and placed in the outside dumpster with a black top, to your left as you exit the rear door. Do not place any cardboard or boxes (pizza, gift, etc.) in the recycle bins or down the chutes, they go to the outside dumpster, this also includes any shredding that is placed in plastic bags, also extra plastic bags that are bundled up. Burned out light bulbs, old and new types, including florescent bulbs are to be put in a bag and placed by the maintenance room. For miscellaneous items such as paint cans and toxic materials,

please notify our maintenance person, who will help you dispose of these items.

In the above **TRASH ROOM** information, it calls for plastic bags to be securely tied before going down the chute. This has been ignored by some owners and creates a problem. I'm sorry you didn't realize there were rules and regulations in condo living before you moved into our building, if you don't agree with some of these, please talk to a Board Member and learn the reasons for rules.
