Batteries

Smoke Alarms: Remember that smoke alarm batteries are each co-owner's responsibility and they are easily replaced. The 9-volt rectangular battery, available at any drug store, supermarket or hardware, slides into a little trap door on the outside of the alarm. Simply push the door and it will open, pull out the old and put in the new battery and you should be good for more than a year. If your alarm is beeping, replace the battery, which is only used when the building loses power, as it did once in December. To be safe, replace the batteries annually.

Balconies: Please put away by mid-January, all lights, wreaths and other festive holiday items decorating your balcony, in keeping with the Lakepointe Towers' Rules and Regulations that require holiday decorations to be removed within two weeks of the end of December.
