Dryer Fans: The board gave the go-ahead to replace a faulty fan unit on the roof that controls the exhaust from clothes dryers in individual units. The repair was necessary and cost \$1,300.

Contractors and Deliveries: Please remember that you are responsible for ensuring that any contractor or delivery person visiting your unit follows Lakepointe Towers rules. Meet them at the back door (never the front), make sure they do not prop open the back door or the elevator, use our dumpster to dispose of construction or packing material, smoke on the grounds or in the building and then follow them out to be certain the door is locked behind them.

Carts

For your convenience, shopping carts are provided in each garage. They are labeled with the location where they belong. If you use a cart, return it to the area that is marked on the cart. Do it right after you use it. Please don't leave it in front of your unit, in the elevator, the lobby, or expect someone else to return it to the correct location because you don't feel like doing it yourself.
